

Personal Injury Insurance Cover

(as from 1 September 2011)

For all TSA registered athletes (incl. athletes with a day licence) between the ages of 12 and 75 years of age covering death, personal injury and disability cover as below:

(A) TSA MEMBERS COVER: (Participating in TSA/Provincial sanctioned events and official TSA organised training programs/camps including foreign events sanctioned by the ITU or an affiliated national federation of the ITU)

- Accidental Death R50,000 (R30,000 for athletes between 12 and 16 years of age)
- Permanent total disablement R50,000
- Temporary total disablement R2,000 per week – maximum 52 weeks **excluding** the first 7 days. (Only applicable if insured person is gainfully employed. Claim cannot exceed 75% of claimant's average weekly earnings and does not apply to athletes under 16 years of age)
- Medical Expenses R20,000 (excess R300 each and every claim)

(B) NON TSA MEMBERS COVER (day licence): (Participating in TSA/Provincial sanctioned events)

- Accidental Death R50,000 (R30,000 for athletes between 12 and 16 years of age)
- Permanent total disablement R50,000
- Temporary total disablement R2000 per week – maximum 52 weeks **excluding** the first 7 days. (Only applicable if insured person is gainfully employed. Claim cannot exceed 75% of claimant's average weekly earnings and does not apply to athletes under 16 years of age)
- Medical expenses R20,000 (Excess R300 each and every claim)

IMPORTANT

- (1) Insurers maximum liability / accumulation limit per accident is R10,000,000.
- (2) Medical expenses cover is only applicable if there is no other cover in place (including medical aid)
